##### AGM

##### Walkie Talkies and Batteries

Wayne has purchased new walkie talkies and rechargeable batteries so we now have two working sets of walkie talkies for use by walk leaders as required. Wayne will send the receipts to Jill for payment in the current financial year.

## **6. Walk Co-ordinator's Report**

Five gaps on the Walk Calendar since the last meeting. The calendar is looking healthy to the end of the year but sparse in the New Year. Looking back over the year there have been 19 gaps, mostly C walks. The opinion was that there has been a swing away from the demand for C walks and a discussion was held around whether walks should be recategorised. It was felt things should be left as they are and that there may well be a swing back towards the longer walks in the future.

A potential new walk leader has come forward – Nicola from Barnsley 20s/30s. Julie is now leading again – her ankle is much better.

Walk reports are still intermittent.

Julie is away on holiday November 25<sup>th</sup> to December 9<sup>th</sup>. Emma will provide cover for the calendar again

Navigation training will be held January 19<sup>th</sup>. Ten members have signed up, an equal split of walk leaders and non walk leaders.

A discussion was held about putting midweek daytime walks on the calendar if they are offered but the conclusion at this stage was that any offers for walks other than at the weekends be directed to Sheffield Ramblers.

Events held since the last committee meeting were the Rail Ale Trail in Cleethorpes, Colin's Greek meal, the Steel City Beer and Cider Festival and the Dam House Bonfire Night.
